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Dear Parents and Carers,

As time moves on, we are reviewing and analysing provision to ensure our remote learning offer remains the best it can be. As we don't have the capability on class dojo to host live sessions, as we are delivering in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 via Showbie, we are going to trial hosting some live sessions via Zoom, for us to be able to engage with our children, catch up on their virtual home learning and allow for some much-needed social interaction with their peers. This is an interim at the moment, until we hopefully begin to use Showbie across Years 1 and 2, when our class iPads arrive.

We know that home learning with young children is extremely difficult, especially if you are working from home, so our aim was to provide independent sessions. We are continuously looking into new ways in which we can provide learning and enhance our teaching at home for the children and to make it easier for all of our families.

Each teacher has thought really carefully about how we can deliver age-appropriate live sessions; with as little disruption to the whole class learning as possible, and so it can fit into the daily timetable around the brilliant virtual learning that is already taking place over class dojo platform. We have REALLY APPRECIATED the very positive feedback received so far. Thank you!

Therefore, we propose that our first session, across Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, will take place on **Monday 25th January**. Many of our children are accessing the learning on class dojo, however we understand the struggle that some parents are having to motivate their child to be as enthusiastic about virtual learning when they have little virtual engagement with the Teaching Teams. We have found some children are struggling to transition between weekends and the working school week. Therefore, we thought that doing a small number of live sessions across the week will benefit us all, as we can check a register, discuss the weather, date, any news and also the learning planned for, over the current or consecutive day.

Here is an outline of how each of the classes will do their live lessons across the week. We have tried to ensure all the classes are consistent but we do understand that some families have children in more than one class, therefore some classes have arranged different times suitable for their learning and Zoom link.

<p>Extra information:</p> <p>Class book (10'clock read) will still be recorded to allow children to access this learning repeatedly over the week if they need to refer to the story for their comprehension or viper questions.</p> <p>The sessions will be run whole class as the children are slightly older and they can begin learning how to contribute to whole class virtual learning as a practise for when the class iPads arrive and we use move to Showbie as our learning platform.</p>			

Staff are very much looking forward to completing all of these live sessions as they will get to see the children over the week. We are going to be completing these sessions whilst in school with our Hub children to ensure we have all tools for learning and so the children can still see that the Hub children are in school and recognise that the learning is still important at home.

Code of conduct

We understand that it will be a really exciting time for the children to see their friends and teachers, but we ask that you remind them to please remember to show their fantastic manners and respect everyone at all times. It is important to listen to their friends and allow everyone to have a turn to talk. We will share a code of conduct over time but this will help as they become more familiar with these platforms and this way of working.


To protect and safeguard our children we also ask if they could do these live sessions in communal areas in the family home (not closed away in a bedroom) and if they can be dressed (not wearing pyjamas).

We will be posting the zoom link directly to you via your class story once they have been set up for the live session. If your child has been split into a group, your class teacher will let you know which group they are to attend. More information will be posted on your class school story page for you to refer back to. Please can we ask that you check that regularly.

We understand that this may be an extra job for many of you to get going but we thank you for all of your continued support, encouragement and involvement during these difficult times as we all try and engage and teach the children the best we possibly can.
